Work directly with the children OR lend a physical hand with the building up of their infrastructure. This project is officially supported by Green Route as part of their “Green Tribe” CSR initiative. <i>Alternative education-based projects can also be suggested.</i>

Duration	1 - 6 hours depending on activity selected. The children are only there in afternoons but other activities can take place during the morning.
