



Karma House - Jordan VolunTourism



Day 1 - Arrival at Queen Alia Airport – Karma representative will meet the guests and assist them through visa procedures. Luggage identification. Travel by Bus to Amman. Check in at hotel for overnight.

Day 2 - Breakfast at hotel – The guests will do a City tour of **Amman**, visiting the Roman Theatre, the Citadel, the King Abdullah Mosque and old and modern Amman. After the city tour and voluntary work we will have lunch.

Suggested Voluntary Programmes:



- Visit of an Orphanage & 'Adopt a Child for a Day', to go for lunch, cinemaetc.
 - Visit to SOS School to spend the day with the students for some activities.
 - Drive to Salt Deaf School to spend a day with the students for some activities.
- Return to Amman hotel for overnight.

Day 3 - Breakfast at hotel – Drive to the North to visit the Roman city of **Jerash**, visiting Maximus Cardo - the colonnaded street, flanked by temples, churches, theatres and endless mosaics. Continue to visit **Ajlun** Castle - an awe-inspiring Islamic fortress that withstood the power of the Crusader armies in the 12th Century. Return to the hotel for overnight.



Suggested Voluntary Programmes in Jerash & Ajlun:

- Planting Olive trees & during Olive Season volunteers can help the locals to harvest the olives.
- Cleaning & maintaining of old school buildings.

Day 4 - Breakfast at hotel – Visit the many churches of Madaba (known as the city of mosaics) to view the famous mosaic map flooring - the Greek Orthodox Church of St. George, the oldest map in the world, depicting the Holy Land. Then continue to visit Mount Nebo - the mountain top memorial of Moses with captivating views of the Jordan Valley, Dead Sea, River Jordan, and the Holy Land. Drive south to Petra, visiting en route the **Kerak Castle**. Overnight in Petra.



Suggested Voluntary Programmes in Kerak:

- Painting or illustrating of the walls in the city – the Castle area.
- Building a shelter for a bus stop.
- Cleaning & maintaining of old school buildings, churches & Mosques

Day 5 - Breakfast at hotel – Full day dedicated to visiting Petra - the Rose Red City. The visit will include the main sites, such as the "Siq" - a long, winding fissure, between two walls of overhanging cliffs, the "Khazneh", referred to as the Treasury, the Street of Facades, the Court House and the Amphitheater. Overnight in Petra.



Suggested Voluntary Programmes in Petra:

- Painting or illustrating the walls in the city.
- Building a shelter for a bus stop.
- Cleaning & maintaining of old school buildings & Mosque.



Day 6 - Breakfast at hotel. Depart to Wadi Rum - the most enchanting desert in the world. With wide, open space and a setting that resembles that of the moon, Wadi Rum will draw you in with its enigmatic lure. Whether you're an avid adventurer or a novice wanderer, while in Wadi Rum we will arrange for a jeep tour for 2 hrs in the desert. After the tour we will drive to the lowest spot on earth - "The Dead Sea" for check-in & overnight.

Suggested Voluntary Programmes in Wadi Rum:

- Fixing & maintaining of the old 4X4 Jeeps.
- Cleaning & maintaining of old school buildings & houses.

Day 7 - Breakfast at hotel – Free day to enjoy the Dead Sea, Hotel Facilities & overnight.

Suggested Voluntary programmes at the Dead Sea:

- Help with the agriculture, planting of trees, watering, harvesting etc.



Day 8 - Breakfast at hotel – Check out from hotel and transfer to Queen Alia Airport for departure with the assistance of Karma House representative.
