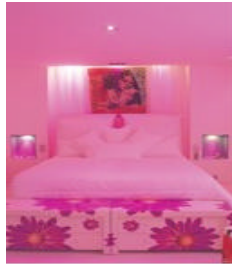
THE CENTRAL LOUNGE... the heart of the resort lies beneath the hotel's glass roof. This living space extends onto a wide fireplace 6 metres in length.

Makeover session at the Pershing Hall



The Pershing Hall is no doubt the work of artists... And first and foremost it is the work of architect Andrée Putman, who signs her very first hotel and restaurant in Paris, revealed behind an elegant 19th century façade, in the heart of Paris' Golden Triangle, only a few minutes away from the Champs Elysées. This place is a gem of design and modernity, in the garden, there are around 250 different variety of plants and flowers, a Patrick Blanc creation.

Here you will spend part of the day, starting with a brunch before meeting with the team of catwalk experts in a private salon, booked for you only, and turned into a studio. You will undergo a total transformation in the hands of professional make-up artists, hairdressers, dressers, who only work for fashion shows and magazines.

A selection of designer clothes and jewellery will be at your disposal, so that you may pick up what suits you the best, what will enhance most your personality, making your dreams come true. In a meantime you'll have been able to have small talk with the designers, whose clothes you are wearing, because they will be on the spot as well.

It will then be time, for the top models you have become, to undergo the shooting session with the photographers, inside the salon turned into a studio and the hotel locations, according to the feeling of the photographers. Your needs will be catered to throughout the afternoon and you will have fun in the meantime! Later, as for any professional, these pictures will be gathered into a book; your book, which will be offered to you before departure.

Ready for a unique evening? Your limos will be waiting for you at the door and will take you right opposite, to the extravagant baroque flat of Paolo Calia.

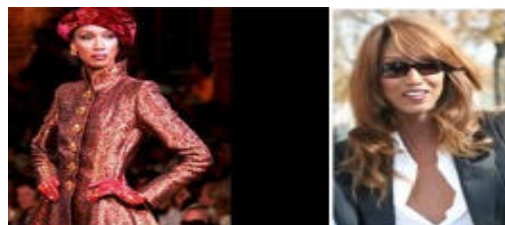
Calia has hosted major parties here with Madonna, Boy George, Prince, Charlotte Rampling and Albert de Monaco, among others. Hundreds of candles bring busts of emperors, Hindu waiters and gilded models to life. Each event is customised and specific décors can be created. One could imagine, for example, four divinely beautiful, golden men serving as candelabra, in pure Cocteau style...

And tonight, you are on stage! The main point is to let fantasy be your guide during this unforgettable dinner.

And what does a socialite or a celebrity do at night? She goes clubbing, but not anywhere, she has her spots, her connections, the ones known by a happy few, where she has the certitude of meeting with her kin... and bumping into paparazzi.

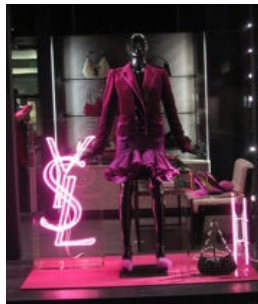
Your handsome male chaperon will be in charge and the name of his fashion studio sums it all "People with attitude".
