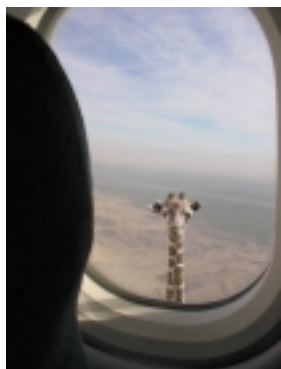

## EVENT CONCEPT - GREECE



The elegant, neoclassical ZAPEION building and its location in the National gardens is a superb venue for the following type of event:

### "ANCIENT GREEK EVENING AT ZAPEION"

Guests arrive by the newest model, air-conditioned deluxe motor coach and are greeted by young men and maidens (in ancient attire) holding flame torches to light the way. ## TEAMBUILDING - ROMANIA



### TREASURE HUNT CONCEPT—SEARCHING FOR THE PRINCE DRACULA

The teams will search for the parts of a knight's armour, to be pieced together at Snagov Monastery, where Dracula is believed to have been buried. The team that finds the vampire's cape will win. *The hunt will take place in three different settings:*

#### Step 1 The Old Court of The Prince Dracula, in the historical part of Bucharest.

The teams will wear costumes from the middle ages and each team will have their own coat of arms. Among the ruins of the Old Court the teams will find written signs on old paper, sealed in wax that will lead them to the antiques shops in the area, where the first parts of the armour will be hidden.

#### Step 2 The Mogosoaia Palace near Bucharest

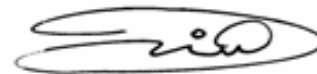
