HOT AIR BALLOON RESTAURANT



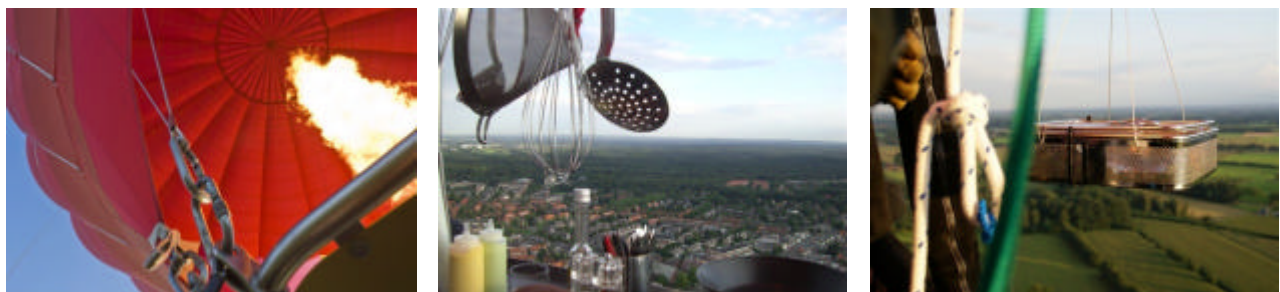
You think you've had your fill? You think you've seen it all? Think again! Using a hot-air balloon has conceived of a world premiere! Allow yourself to drift away on airborne gastronomy - gourmet foods and superb wines will take you as close as you will get to cuisine heaven!

With a volume of 8,000 cubicle metres and a height of 45 metres, a balloon can function as a gargantuan hot-air fan oven. But can such a huge space be heated to a point where one can cook in it? It most certainly can – internal balloon temperatures may rise to around 80 to 100 degrees Celsius, which means, in kitchen terms, that food can be cooked slowly at 'low' temperatures. This is the ideal method for aroma development and for retaining the juices in fish or meat dishes.

Using an ingenious pulley construction, the dishes are transported to the crown of the balloon envelope. After cooking, the lobster, sea bass, or guinea-fowl is hoisted down to the specially arranged kitchen, where it will be finished off to perfection along with crisp vegetables and a delicious sauce. After as little as twenty minutes of flying, the first dishes are presented.

Temperature sensors have been installed inside the balloon, which can be inspected from the kitchen basket during flight. This allows the chef to determine exactly whether dishes should be slightly lowered or raised over the heat source in order to achieve a perfect result. The finished dishes are presented in style, and guests are able to enjoy both tastes and views from their tables.

"Marsh Walking" across the Waddensea

Holland is one of the few countries in the world where you can walk from the mainland to a nearby island. The island of Ameland lies north of Friesland in the most northern part of the Netherlands. During low-tide a specialised guide will walk a group of approx. 15 enthusiast nature lovers across the Waddensea to the isle of Ameland. The trip takes about 3½ to 4 hours. (13kms or 8 miles)

Depending on the tides your trip may start in the middle of the night, early morning or in the middle of the day. Whenever you go...it is always beautiful and challenging. The return is always by boat and it is a strange and wonderful sensation having walked where you now float and sail on a comfortable ferry.

Marsh walking (Wadlopen in Dutch) is a unique experience. Only deserts have the same openness and loneliness. Except for the birds and seals you may encounter, animals rest during low tides and birds find a abundance of food as soon as the sea withdraws. Low tide during the day provides comfortable bathing opportunities for the seals.

Although many take the opportunity and walk the marshes, you are still one of the few that experience this challenge. This day you are Dutch with the Dutch.
