






## UNIQUE IDEAS FOR YOUR NEXT EVENT

- Count Dracula invites you to his castle The most popular Romanian castle, belonging to the famous Romania's
   Queen Mary and far better known for one fictional resident: Count Dracula. Up to 40 pax
- Visit the 2nd largest administrative building in the world after the Pentagon, the Parliament Palace The building, actually hosting Romania's democratically elected Parliament, is also known as "Ceausescu's Palace" and clearly reflects the megalomania of the communist leader Nicolae Ceausescu.
- Experience the authentic Romanian village life One day trip from one of the main cities of Romania will bring visitors the opportunity to visit traditional villages in Transylvania, Maramures or Bucovina regions. Here guests may experience a traditional homemade delicious meal in the middle of nature with transportation via horse carts, enjoy local folklore, crafts and traditions well preserved by locals.
- Enjoy a gala dinner in a tent situated in the courtyard of an old palace or manor Close to Bucharest there is a chain of picturesque lakes and areas that can host a gala dinner in a tent offering the perfect mixture between the interior space and natural ambient no matter the season. Up to 150 pax
- Visit an open-air museum /location or local farm The open-air ethnographic museum "Dimitrie Gusti" in Bucharest is showcasing traditional Romanian village life, which can be explored by guests by interacting with the local craftsmen exposing the products of their crafts and trying to "steal" from their art and talent (painting ceramics, carving wood, weaving textiles, glass painting, mask manufacturing a.s.o.) by taking lessons from the "teachers". All of this can be organized with folk entertainment performed by traditional singers and dancers. Up to 150 pax
- Romanian wine tasting Azuga Rhein Cellars are the oldest "location" where the sparkling wine has continuously been produced over time using the traditional method. . Up to 30 pax
- Sighisoara is the only inhabited citadel of its kind in Europe and it is surrounded by fortified walls, inviting the
  guests to visit an UNESCO World Heritage Site bursting with gorgeous Gothic and Saxon architecture.
- The Danube Delta Home to over 300 species of birds, 160 species of fish, and the greatest expanse of reed beds in the world. It offers a variety of fauna and flora unique in Europe, so it is a wonderful place for visitors enjoying a boat ride in the middle of wild nature, exploring the Delta habitat and tasting the delicious fish products prepared by locals.
- Turda salt mine Situated close to the city of Cluj dates from the Middle Ages and after the recent renovation, it houses a Ferris wheel, a boating lake, a sports arena, a bowling lane, and a museum. Additionally, visitors can play mini golf, enjoy a spa treatment, or admire the 1000-year-old stalagmites and spectacular light displays that decorate the interiors, all at 400ft underground.
