3 Days Program Vienna

2024

Day 1

“Vienna is a compact city with a huge selection of meeting venues. Everything is just a moment away, and every trip is a voyage of discovery. Perfectly relaxed.”

Vienna is the international capital of classical music, of the Waltz King Johann Strauss and of balls conducted in the unparalleled splendor of the city’s palaces but Vienna does not live in the past; it is a modern city in which contemporary creativity lives in harmony with the city’s rich heritage.

Arrival at Vienna Schwechat Airport with special customs clearance in the VIP lounge where refreshments, cocktails are served with a small live orchestra giving a lasting first impression of Vienna.

Transfer to Vienna with a stop at the famous Sacher; an Austrian institution for coffee and cake

Check-in hotel.

Evening, depart by vintage tram to enjoy a typical vineyard dinner with buffet, music and wine throughout the evening. Return by deluxe coach.



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Day 2

Tour of the "Imperial City". A drive along the famous "Ringstraße", with its impressive buildings, such as the State Opera, Hofburg Imperial Palace, Museum of Fine Arts, Museum of Natural History, Parliament, City Hall and the ancient University.

Enjoy a walking tour between Stephan's Dome and Hofburg Imperial Winter Palace. During the walk visit the Spanish Riding School and after that up to the famous coffee houses to try Viennese cake and coffee. The Viennese coffee houses are known around the globe for their informal pleasantness, as an oasis of gemütlichkeit

Cocktails are served at our downtown lunch venue. Viennese Cuisine is the only cuisine in the world to be named after a city.

After lunch continue to the Schönbrunn Palace - the former summer Residence of the Habsburgs. Each room has its own story to tell!

Return to the hotel.

Evening at leisure with several suggestions for a "Dine Around", or a visit of a performance at the Vienna Opera house.



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Day 3

The tour leaves Vienna to Wachau, often described as "Austria's most beautiful 35 km". Located along the banks of the Danube between Melk and Krems, the Wachau surely is one of the most romantic and enchanting riverscapes of Europe. Here the mighty stream is framed by soft hills and terraces of wine and fruit plantations.

First stop is the Benedictine Abbey of Melk. Situated on a plateau overseeing the Danube, this baroque monument is a perfect example of harmony between architecture and landscape. Particularly the library with more than 80.000 volumes and manuscripts is extremely impressive. Lunch will be served in a restaurant nearby.

After lunch, the public boat takes you down the Blue Danube to Dürnstein, one of the prettiest places in the Wachau. During the boat trip to Dürnstein history will arise back to live – Dürnstein is the town where King Lionheart has been captived and liberated by his true servant Blondel. On arrival there will be some free time to stroll around this medieval town.

Coach transfer back to Vienna.

In the evening leave the hotel by horse drawn carriages to one of the ancient palaces in Vienna, such as the Hofburg Imperial Palace, Gardenpalais Liechtenstein or the Palais Ferstel.

Fanfare trumpeters announce the guest's arrival before cocktails, followed by a gala dinner and Viennese show.

Return shuttle coach transfers.



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
