Athens Market - Wake up with the City

Drive to the centre of Athens for a walk through the lively fish/meat & produce markets. Here the stall-holders offer their goods to the passing shoppers. Various meats and seafood are spread across benches for selection. Across the road, the produce market offers fresh vegetables and fruit and the old warehouse style stores containing barrel upon barrel of any variety of olive. Guests are free to shop.

Tucked away in a corner of the meat market are 3-4 traditional 24 hour eateries. Here the market diners are at their liveliest in the wee small hours of the morning.

Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant and then transfer back to hotel.

Dinner will be at the Old Stables for a "fun" night. As the name suggests, the original building once housed livestock. Its courtyard surrounded by trees and local flora, the Old Stables with its charming rustic atmosphere offers a taste of the Greek countryside.
