

DAY ONE

End your day with a tranquil moment on the golden sands of Gordon Beach, where you can witness the sun set, casting hues of orange and pink across the Mediterranean Sea.



DAY TWO

Venture to the ancient port city of Jaffa, located just south of Tel Aviv.

Wander through the alleyways of Jaffa's Old City, where ancient stone buildings and art galleries intertwine. Discover the iconic Jaffa Clock Tower, a symbol of the city's rich heritage.

While in Jaffa, visit the picturesque Jaffa Flea Market, a treasure trove of unique antiques, handicrafts, vintage finds and engage with local vendors and artists

Neve Tzedek, one of Tel Aviv's oldest neighbourhoods and stroll through the charming alleys lined with colourful houses, boutique shops, and artistic cafés. Don't miss the renowned Suzanne Dellal Centre for Dance and Theatre, which hosts a diverse range of cultural performances and events.

Head north to the ancient city of Caesarea, a historical gem along the Mediterranean coast.

Explore the Caesarea National Park, where Roman ruins and ancient amphitheatres stand as testaments to the city's past. Stroll along the picturesque harbour and absorb the captivating blend of history and natural beauty as you enjoy the sun coming down.

In the evening, savour the cuisine at Tel Aviv's trendy restaurants, where the culinary scene fuses traditional Middle Eastern flavours with innovative culinary creations.

- Experience the cutting-edge F-16 and F-35 flight simulators and soar over landscapes and holy sites in The Squadron, an advanced fighter jet simulator.
- Graffiti Tour & Workshop - Learn to create a Graffiti and bring home your own unique Graffiti Work of Art.
- Walk the Saron Tunnels - A network of underground tunnels, connecting a templars' village wine cellars, which during the War of Independence in 1948 were used to rebuild and hide the few airplanes of the fledgling Israeli army.

DAY THREE

Your journey will take you to the sacred city of Jerusalem, a place steeped in spirituality and history. Visit the Western Wall, where you'll stand before the ancient stones and feel the solemnity as worshippers pray fervently.

Venture into the Jewish Quarter, where cobbled streets and the restored Cardo paint a vivid picture of an era long past.

Follow the Via Dolorosa, retracing the footsteps of history, and including the Church of the Holy Sepulchre with its architectural grandeur. Reach the summit of the Mount of Olives to witness a panoramic view of Jerusalem below.

Experience the vibrant atmosphere of Machane Yehuda Market, immersing yourself in the city's diverse cultural fabric.

DAY FOUR
