
Granville Island Public Market

Voices from Vancouver's past mingle with the sounds of nature, beautiful gardens skirt colourful totem poles, British Columbia First Nations artisans chisel legend into cedar and Capilano Suspension Bridge takes you to the serenity of a West Coast rainforest and Canada's award-winning tourist attraction, Treetops Adventure. Admission to the park includes the Suspension Bridge, Cliff Walk & Tree Top Adventure.

Suspension Bridge

Originally built in 1889, Capilano Suspension Bridge stretches 450 feet (137m) across and 230 feet (70m) above Capilano River.

Cliffwalk

Cliffwalk follows a granite precipice along Capilano River with a labyrinth-like series of narrow cantilevered bridges, stairs and platforms. With only 16 anchor points in the cliff supporting the structure, the new Cliffwalk is both environmentally sensitive and adrenaline pumping!

Treetops Adventure

Treetops Adventure offers a squirrel's eye view of a thriving coastal rainforest in the mid-story of 1300-year-old old growth Douglas-firs. Treetops Adventure uses an innovative compression system using no bolts or nails in the trees to secure its viewing platforms and 7 suspension bridges.

Grouse Mountain with optional private gondola Skyride

Step onboard the famous Grouse Mountain Skyride, and get ready to experience a one-mile journey like no other. High above towering Douglas fir, breathtaking views of the city of Vancouver, sparkling Pacific Ocean, Gulf Islands, and snowy peaks unfold as you journey up the mountainside.

Admission tickets include: scenic round trip Skyride, Lumberjack Shows, Birds in Motion demonstrations, Ranger Talks at the Bear Habitat, movies in the Theatre in the Sky, access to the Chalet & alpine shopping.

Lunch in Lupins Café on Grouse Mountain (exclusive)

Sightseeing in Banff National Park

Banff and Lake Louise area sightseeing tour

Tour this mountain wilderness that includes wind-shaped hoodoos, Bow Falls and Tunnel Mountain Drive with its spectacular view of the Bow River Valley. Then see the renowned Banff Springs Hotel, Peyto Lake, and Emerald Lake. As you follow a winding path through the Bow Valley you witness spectacular landscapes such as Johnston Canyon, Moraine Lake and the Valley of the Ten Peaks.

Lake Minnewanka Boat Cruise – 1 hour – Lakes could be frozen until the middle of June Explore the largest lake in Banff National Park on this magnificent one hour interpretive cruise that introduce s the rugged paradise richly steeped in history, native folklore and geology. Travel on a modern Lake Cruiser, as an experienced captain and entertaining guide explore the 'water of the spirits' and share tales of First Nations people and early explorers that first discovered the area. Learn about the tremendous forces that created the surrounding mountains and stay on the lookout for wildlife that frequent the lake.

Sulphur Mountain Gondola – 1 – 1.5 hours

You will ride to the top for breath taking views of the mountain ranges and valleys. The adventure begins with an eight minute journey to the summit of Sulphur Mountain in a modern, fully-enclosed four passenger gondo la cabin. The views become increasingly spectacular as you climb 698m (2,292 ft) to an elevation of 2,281m (7,486 ft) at the Summit Upper Terminal – the departure point for a mountaintop of activities.

After the morning tours, the group will can select to have lunch or dinner at Sky Bistro restaurant or dinner at Fairmont Chateau Lake Louise.
