

AGENTOURS' CARBON NEUTRAL INCENTIVE PROGRAM FEATURING THE ORCHARD GARDEN HOTEL IN SAN FRANCISCO

Day 1

Arrival to San Francisco International Airport. Transfer to the **Orchard Garden Hotel**.

Dinner and overnight in the city's only **LEED-certified "green" hotel, the Orchard Garden**.

Day 2

Morning walking tour of Union Square, North Beach and Chinatown, with lunch at the Ferry Building. Board the public transit electric trolley to Fisherman's Wharf where the group will enjoy a fun tour of the waterfront and Marina aboard electric Segway scooters. Return by Cable Car to the hotel. Walk to dinner this night.



Day 3

Morning bus ride to Fisherman's Wharf to pick up small Electric Cars for a GPS-guided, self-drive tour of San Francisco's outer neighborhoods. Upon return of the cars to Fisherman's Wharf the group will have lunch on Pier 39 overlooking the Bay. After lunch the group will be fitted to their bikes, be given helmets and will be guided across the Golden Gate Bridge on a scenic bike ride, ending in Sausalito.



From there a minibus will take the group to Muir Woods for a nature walk among the giant Redwood Trees and then they will return to Sausalito. Just after sundown the group finish this day of incredible activity with a moonlight kayak trip on San Francisco Bay (in the quiet water of Richardson Bay). Dinner in Sausalito afterwards and then a return by bus to the Orchard



Garden Hotel.

Day 4

Morning free. Then transfer by bus to Pier 40 to board a sailing boat or catamaran for the 2 hour sail to Angel Island State Park in the center of San Francisco Bay. Free time to hike or play volleyball, and then enjoy a BBQ lunch on the island prepared by our boating staff. Then return sail back to San Francisco in the mid-afternoon for a return transfer to the hotel and free time. Walk to dinner this night for a final night celebration of this incredibly diverse, ecologically-sound tour of San Francisco.



Day 5

Transfer to departure flight back home.

ORCHARD GARDEN HOTEL INFORMATION



Orchard Garden is the first of a new generation in hotels, because the hotel was built to earn the coveted “Leadership in Energy & Environmental Design” (LEED®) Green Building Rating System certification. This is the nationally accepted benchmark for the design, construction, and operation of high performance green buildings. LEED promotes a whole-building approach to sustainability by recognizing performance in five key areas of human and environmental health: sustainable site development, water savings, energy efficiency, materials selection, and indoor environmental quality.

Features include San Francisco’s first guestroom key card energy control system, similar to European and Asian systems, resulting in an energy savings of 20%. The hotel’s ‘green’ practices also include in-room paper recycling system, soy-based inks, chemical-free cleaning products, compact fluorescent light bulbs and a 100% tobacco-free environment. The décor supports the hotel’s ‘green’ efforts by offering carpet pads with 100% recycled content and low emission material, maple wood furniture certified by the Forest Stewardship Council Forest Council and constructed without off-gassing solvent-based glues.
