

▼ Diving Clean Up

PADI Discover Scuba Diving (DSD) consists of an in depth lecture on Scuba Diving followed by shallow dives. The first dive will be conducted in a swimming pool or shore area and the second dive will be conducted in the open water. All underwater skills/exercises will be practised during the first dive. The average time spent underwater on both dives will be of approximate 45 minutes. After the completion of both dives a PADI Certification will be given to each student.

***Note:** A Customer Registration Form must be filled in prior to any Scuba Diving activities. This form also contains a Diving Medical Statement. Should any of the contra indications in this form be ticked positively then a proper diving medical will be done by our doctor at an extra medical cost. If the candidate passes this medical examination then they will be given the go ahead to scuba dive.)*

After the initial DSD the guests will proceed with the Corporate Social Responsibility Activity. This event consists of an underwater clean up. The site chosen for this clean-up will depend on the weather conditions of the day, however, the bay known as Il-Foss in Valletta right underneath the lands department or along the Sliema coast are usually great sites for this type of event. This Valletta site is very famous because of the shipwreck that lies there in 14 meters of water called HMS Maori which attracts thousands of tourists and many locals to the area. These areas are rarely cleaned and will be well received by the public, especially the diving enthusiasts.

The whole event will be filmed above and under water and all documentation will be donated for promotional / educational purposes.
